The primary focus of my current research is "Neuropathic pain"- to study the potential treatment for the drug induced neuropathy and to study the mechanism that produces the neuropathy and screen them for therapeutic potentials. A complete knowledge of pathophysiology of neuropathic pain requires the development of additional models with their different aetiologies than those presently used such as trauma and metabolic models. The absence of knowledge concerning mechanisms of chemotherapy- induced neuropathic pain has hindered the development of new treatment strategies. Vincristine, an antineoplastic agent widely used in cancer chemotherapy for both solid tumors and haematological malignancies, is predictably and uniformly neurotoxic to all patients who receive it, and this neurotoxicity is the limiting factor in the use of the drug. My purpose of this research is to develop neuropathy in animal and to study how the drug causes neuropathy in them by measuring the biochemical parameters like neuropeptides level in brain. And then screening them for their therapeutic potentials for mechanical hyperalgesia and allodynia.

Highlights of the work:

It acts as a means of limiting vincristine neurotoxicity and could potentially increase the usefulness of vincristine as antineoplastics

It may be helpful for the development of newer model for the screening of neuropathy
