4.	Early intervention for children with special needs (Vidya Sudha)	This program caters to the needs of children with cognitive impairment below the age of 5 yrs. Speech and language therapy, swallowing and feeding therapy, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, psychologist's consultation, special education and counselling the family is undertaken under the same roof. Karthikeyan Child Development Unit (KCDU)	A multidisciplinary child development clinic with Dept of Neonatology, Paediatrics, Ophthalmology, Clinical Psychology, Clinical nutrition & Physiotherapy along with Dept.of SLHS who are involved in assessing children with high risk factors. 6.	Language group therapy for children	Promoting group communication skills and peer group interaction through group activities	Dr. R.C. Perumal
7.	Stuttering group therapy	Summer programme for children with stuttering focussing on improving fluency skills during peer group interaction.	Dr. Amudhu Sankar
8.	New born hearing screening program (NHS)	Helps in early detection and diagnose children and infant with hearing loss as early as 1 month	Dr. Heramba Ganapathy S.
9.	Early intervention for children with hearing impairment	Special education to habilitate young children with hearing impairment below 3 years of age. This will facilitate integration into regular school as early as possible	Ms Selvi and Ms Raji
10.	Cochlear Implant Program of SRMC (CLIPS)	An advanced technique in the treatment of children and adults with hearing impairment who do not get enough benefit from conventional hearing aids. Works along with the Dept of ENT. Aural habilitation services are also provided.	Ms. Prathiba Dawson
11.	Hearing aid clinic	Hearing aid benefit trial for children and adults using functional gain and real ear measurement. Customization of hearing aid response with hearing aid programming. Measurement of electro-acoustic characteristics	Ms. Muthuselvi T

12.	Tinnitus clinic	Tinnitus retraining therapy for clients with tinnitus (sound in the ear that irritates the client)	Dr. Vidya Ramkumar
13.	Auditory Processing Disorder (APD) clinic	Works on diagnosing auditory processing difficulties using specialized tests and provides strategies to improve auditory perception	Ms. Jayashree S
