Guidelines for award of Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research Founder-Chancellor Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Scheme

Preamble:

In order to aid meritorious and brilliant but poor/unaffordable students undergoing courses of study in the constituent units of Sri Ramachandra (Deemed to be University) the parent Trust, Sri Ramachandra Educational and HealthTrust, has set apart fund to award scholarships.

The Scholarship Scheme shall be called "Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research – Founder Chancellor Merit-cum-Means Scholarship. The students who have passed I year University examinations (annual or semesters) are only eligible.

1. The scholarships awarded will be towards full or partial tuition fee payable by the students and are tenable for the year of award only.
2. The scholarship will be awarded to meritorious but poor students, whose parental/guardian's annual income is Rs. 3 lakhs or less.
3. Students applying for the award of scholarship shall submit proof of annual income duly certified by the appropriate government authority/from the employer of parent/s.
4. However, outstanding meritorious students with State/Central merit ranks in the qualifying examinations will also be considered for award of scholarship irrespective of their parental annual income.
5. Students who are enjoying any scholarship through other agencies, will not be eligible to apply for scholarships under this scheme.
6. The scholarships will be awarded to students undergoing the undergraduate paramedical courses, who satisfy the above criterion 2 and 5 and who score the highest marks, from among the applicants, in the previous year University Examinations (annual or semester examinations marks taken together) and studying second to final year of the course under the faculties of Pharmacy, Biomedical Sciences, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Allied Health Sciences, Management, Public Health and Sports Sciences.
7. Students desiring to avail of the scholarships shall apply in the prescribed application form, through the Head of the Department/Course Chairman/ Principal, with attested copies of their marks statement of the previous year University examinations and income certificate.
8. In all matters connected with or arising from the above, the decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final.
