

Organs of brain-dead man saves lives

Chennai: Organs of a man aged 33, who was declared brain dead by doctors at Sri Ramachandra Medical Centre (SRMC), were donated. A release said that K Sriram of Pozhichalur, Chennai was admitted to the hospital with severe head injury on September 30 after he met with a road accident. His condition did not improve in spite of treatment and he was declared brain dead on October 2. Liver, corneas and heart valves were harvested. His liver was transplanted on a veterinary doctor from Salem and corneas and heart valves were utilised by SRMC. ENS
