Chennai: Sri Ramachandra Medical Centre has got the approval of Atomic Energy Regulatory Board to use high-dose isotope therapy to test treatments for thyroid and neuroendocrine cancers. Isotopes are radioactive material that can kill the cancer cells, but AERB regulates the safe usage of these.

A press release said it has been providing nuclear scans and low-dose isotope therapies since 1995. "SRMC now has all facilities for diagnosis and treatment of various cancers," the release said.
