- Hemoglobin
- Fasting blood sugar
- FT4, TSH
- Pap smear
- Sono mammogram

How much?

- A cost of concessional amount of Rs.500 will be collected in room no -11
- Kamalatmika stickers will be pasted on the top of OP registration file for identification.

Details

- After the payment employee /staff are advised to do the blood tests in the ground floor sample collection area.
- Pap smear will be done in 3rd floor OBG OPD by faculty only.
- Sonomammogram will be done based on appointments given at radiology department in ground floor and report shall be collected at the same area.
- Lab and pap smear reports shall be collected from room number-12 lab counter ground floor.
