#### INTRODUCTION AND RELEVANCE:

The fellowship program is a specially curated program with a professional approach for individuals looking to excel in Clinical Dentistry. It will allow the one to get hands on experience with patients and perform various outlined procedures to develop confidence in selecting and handling Esthetic cases. It will also allow the participating Dentist to develop an aesthetic sense for planning treatment of esthetically challenging cases. The Fellowship program also provides the dentist with an excellent opportunity to get upskilled by getting exposed to the latest technologies and by receiving training in the various advancements in the field of aesthetic dentistry.

This Fellowship program strives to create an environment for participating Dentist to visualize and achieve Esthetic Outcomes under the guidance of highly skilled Professionals with a stimulating one on one approach. It will also create confidence and opportunities for the participating Dentists to achieve better career trajectory owing to their newly acquired knowledge and skillset. This Fellowship program will be a hallmark of the participating Fellow's desire to excel and distinguish themselves in the field of aesthetic restorative dentistry.

This training program is for BDS graduates who hold a valid registered degree. MDS professionals who also wish to sub- specialize in this new field and develop the skills needed to succeed in Aesthetic restorative Dentistry will also benefit immensely from this Fellowship Program.

#### **AIM OF THE PROGRAM:**

To acquire knowledge and skillset for performing Aesthetic restorative Dental procedures in Clinical Practice

## Objectives of the program:

- 1. To acquire knowledge regarding cosmetic esthetic procedures and identify clinical conditions indicated for such procedures.
- 2. To learn about the basics of Dental Photography and develop skills to document Aesthetic Restorative procedures.
- 3. To acquire knowledge and develop skills to clinically perform Resin infiltration, Microabrasion, Macroabrasion, Bleaching, Aesthetic direct Composite restorations.
- 4. To acquire adequate knowledge and develop skills regarding adhesive bonding protocols, Resin based composites and Porcelain Laminate Veneers.
- 5. To acquire adequate knowledge and develop skills regarding Tooth preparation techniques, Provisionalization methods and Impression Materials for Full Coverage Esthetic Anterior Crowns.
- 6. To acquire knowledge and develop skills to clinically using Diode Lasers for Soft tissue correction as needed for Aesthetic restorative procedures

#### REGULATIONS FOR FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME IN "AESTHETIC RESTORATIVE DENTISTRY"

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Candidate for admission to the Fellowship Program in 'Aesthetic Restorative Dentistry' shall be required to possess the following qualifications:

- (a) He/she must have qualified for the BDS (Bachelor in Dental Surgery) / MDS- any specialty (Master in Dental Surgery) from this University or of any other University recognized as equivalent thereto by the authority of this University and the Dental Council of India and obtained permanent registration from any of the State Dental Councils.
- (b) The admitting authorities of the Sri Ramachandra Dental Center will strictly ensure that every candidate admitted to the Fellowship Program in Diode Lasers in Dentistry has obtained permanent registration certificate from any one of the State Dental Councils.

#### REGISTRATION

A candidate admitted to Fellowship Program in Aesthetic Restorative Dentistry of Sri Ramachandra Dental Center, Porur, Chennai-600116, shall register his/her name with the Dental Center by remitting the prescribed fees along with the application for registration duly filled in and forwarded to the Medical Superintendent (Dental) of the Sri Ramachandra Dental Center.

#### **DURATION OF THE COURSE:**

The period of certified study and training for the Fellowship Program in 'Aesthetic Restorative Dentistry' in Dentistry shall be 10 months for the award of Fellowship certificate.

#### **COMMENCEMENT OF THE COURSE:**

The academic year for the Fellowship Program in 'Aesthetic Restorative Dentistry' would, commence from the month of December of 2023.

#### ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION

No candidate shall be permitted to appear for the Examination unless he/she puts in 90% attendance during his/her period of study and training and produces the necessary certificate of study, attendance and progress from the Course Director.

#### CONDONATION OF LACK OF ATTENDANCE

There shall be no condonation of lack of attendance for students of the Fellowship Program. (90 %)

#### CRITERIA FOR COMPLETION

A candidate registered for the Fellowship Program in 'Aesthetic Restorative Dentistry' must complete the designated quota of clinical exercises satisfactorily and obtain pass marks in the Assessments following each module.

#### MAINTENANCE OF LOG BOOK

- 1. Every Fellow shall maintain a record of skills he/she has acquired during the training period certified by the Course Director/ Faculty of Department under whom he/she has undergone training.
- 2. In addition, the Course Director shall encourage the Fellows in Seminars, Journal Club, Group Discussions and to participate in Conferences to further their exposure and knowledge.
- 3. The Course Director shall scrutinize the logbook once at end of every module.
- 4. The logbook should be submitted at the time of clinical/practical examination for the scrutiny of the Board of Examiners.

#### **Award of Certificate**

Certificate will be awarded duly signed by Course Director of the Fellowship program, Medical Superintendent [Dental] of Sri Ramachandra Dental College and Hospital. This program does not come under the purview of Dental Council of India and is not an additional registerable qualification with the Dental Council of India

#### **Scheme of Training Programme**

Protocols for Training: Module Based Training system- 4 modules of training 7 working days of training per module over 8 months.

- 1. **FIRST MODULE**: Isolation Methods, Basics of Dental Photography, Micro and Macroabrasion, Resin Infiltration, Teeth Bleaching, Direct Composite Restorations Class I, II, III, IV and V.
- 2. **SECOND MODULE**: Fractured tooth rehabilitation. Direct Composite Veneers and Midline Diastema Closure.
- 3. **THIRD MODULE**: Bonded esthetic fiber post and core, Tooth Preparation, Impression making and Provisionalization for Anterior Esthetic Crowns.
- 4. **FINAL MODULE**: Smile Designing principles and Porcelain Laminate Veneers, Soft Tissue Lasers for zenith correction, gingivectomy and non crown lengthening (Non Surgical).
