Agenda 1

Need for financial support to the family at this critical juncture was presented and justified by the members from the first 03 batches. This request was accepted by all the members and agreed on a onetime payment of Rs. 25000 as a support to the alumnus family from the SLHS alumni chapter fund.

Agenda 2

Opening an alumni family welfare scheme

It was discussed that two conditions will be covered under this scheme; a) demises and b) permanent disability. To be a part of this scheme, the members have to pay Rs. 500 as a onetime payment only then they are eligible to get benefit out of this scheme. It was decided to increase the membership registration amount to Rs. 2500 from the year 2021 onwards. From the collected amount Rs. 2000 will be added to

SLHS chapter corpus fund and Rs. 500 will be deposited in alumni family welfare scheme. These will be intimated to the members at the time of registration.
