BDS Admission Notification for Stray Vacancy Round – (2018-19)

(To fill-up the vacant seats in B.D.S. course after mop-up round conducted by MCC of DGHS)

All eligible candidates (whose details have been uploaded in the website of MCC of DGHS, Govt. of India, after 2nd mop-up round on 11.09.2018) are invited to "Register online" in this website, **from 12.09.2018 6.00 a.m. to 13.09.2018 11.59 p.m.**

2. The candidates are informed to go through the 'important instructions for candidates for admission to B.D.S. course (hosted on this website)' and keep ready the required certificates (in original) and other requirements specified therein.

3. The tentative schedule for counseling and admission is as follows:-

NOTE:

1. Candidates should report punctually at the time and date indicated in the mail, at the venue for counseling (i.e., University Auditorium, Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research (Deemed to be University), Porur, Chennai-116), without fail.
2. No request will be entertained for change of date and time of counseling. The candidate who do not turn-up for counseling at the prescribed time and date, will forfeit their candidature for counseling/admission.
3. Only those candidates who fulfill all the prescribed eligibility criteria prescribed by the MCC/DCI/this University will be considered for admission on merit basis, in the order of NEET All-India-Rank. Mere "Online Registration" by the candidates or "receipt of e-mail" from the Deemed to be University shall not entitle the candidates to counseling or admission.
4. On successful completion of online registration, candidates will get intimation through email to that effect.
5. If any candidate fails either to produce the required certificates (in original) or make payment of the specified tuition fee and other fees, he/she will not be considered for counseling and admission.
6. The vacancy position on BDS, at the end of MCC of DGHS mop-up round counseling on 11.09.2018 are **4 (Four) seats**.

- b) The candidates must fulfill all the eligibility criteria prescribed by the DCI for admission to BDS Allotment for admission is subject to fulfillment of all the eligibility criteria and medical fitness of the candidates.
 - c) The candidates should report along with **original certificates and Demand Draft** for tuition and other fees or UTR No. for **Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS** as specified herein below.
2. The candidates should bring the following certificates/documents **in Original** (along with 2 sets of photocopies of the same):-
 - i. Allotment order issued by the MCC of DGHS, New Delhi
 - ii. NEET (UG) – 2018 Admit Card
 - iii. NEET (UG) - 2018 Result Card
 - iv. Copy of Aadhaar Card
 - v. HSC or equivalent mark statement
 - vi. 10th mark / grade statement / Birth certificate
 - vii. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate / Migration certificate
 - viii. Six Passport size & Two Stamp size colour photographs of the candidate (same as in NEET admit card photograph) and one Passport size photograph of the candidates Father and Mother, Photograph of Local guardian if applicable.
 - ix. Any one of the identification proofs (ID Proof as mentioned in the information Bulletin published by the CBSE. i.e., (PAN Card/ Driving License/ Voter ID/ Passport).

 - i. Candidates without original certificates / documents, shall **not** be allowed to Participate in the counseling.
 - ii. Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other institute/college/University and come for admission with a certificate stating that “their original certificates are deposited with institute/college/University” shall **not** be allowed to participate in the counseling.

3. Hostel facility:

- i. Standard Rooms with common facilities can be given to the students who want to stay in the Hostel immediately. However, request for allotment of Hostel Room with specific facility will be subject to availability of the same and it will take a minimum of two weeks to provide a particular type of room.
- ii. Within 3 days after the last day of the academic year, the hostler should vacate the room compulsorily in order to facilitate annual maintenance work.
- iii. When the hostler reports at the start of next academic session, some other room earmarked for the 'specific batch of students' in a Block/floor only, will be allotted by the Chief Warden. No student will be allowed to stay in a particular room continuously.

4. General:

- i. If a candidate fails to report on the date and time specified by MCC of DGHS in the allotment order along with the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee by Demand Draft/Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS with UTR No. (For NRI Students through Wire Transfer) on the day of admission, he/she will not be permitted to proceed with the admission process. The vacancy arising therefrom will be duly notified to the DGHS.
- ii. If any candidate withdraws from the course of study in which he/she was admitted, after the expiry of the cut-off date prescribed for admission to that course of study or in mid-term and the seat is rendered vacant, the first year fee paid will be forfeited and the student will also be required to remit the 'entire course fee' for the remaining years of the course period.
- iii. Students will be governed by the University rules including rules for refund of fee, disciplinary rules, hostel rules and UGC/MCI/DCI Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging: For a copy of the Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research (Deemed to be University) Student Manual, please visit www.sriramachandra.edu.in.
- iv. At the time of admission, candidates should sign declaration/undertakings declaring that they shall abide by the rules and regulations of the University including anti-ragging Regulations of the UGC/MCI/DCI disciplinary rules for students and the University rules on payment of fees/refund of fees.
